# NHS Increasing Capacity Framework - Terms of Use

Last updated: 20 November 2020

# The Increasing Capacity Framework website was established to provide NHS users with a simple search site to find providers who can help increase capacity.

The site contains the results of the **Increasing Capacity Framework** contract and as such contains sensitive commercial information. Information and logins should not be shared with any other person or organisation and especially not with any provider on the framework. IP addresses are tracked (for security reasons only) to provide evidence of misuse and usage is reported on a regular basis to NHSE/I and NHS Arden & GEM CSU (as contract owners). If evidence is provided that you have breached these terms of use, NHSE/I may take appropriate action with your trust's Information Governance Officer and Finance Director.

These Terms of Use, together with any and all other documents referred to herein, set out the terms of use under which you may use the website, <u>www.increasingcapactiyframework.co.uk</u> ("Our Site"). Please read these Terms of Use carefully and ensure that you understand them. Your agreement to comply with and be bound by these Terms is deemed to occur upon your first use of Our Site and every subsequent use.

#### 1. Definitions and Interpretation

1.1 In these Terms of Use, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the following meanings:

**Account** means an account required for a User to access certain areas of Our Site, as detailed in Clause 4;

**Content** means any and all text, images, audio, video, scripts, code, software, databases and any other form of information capable of being stored on a computer that appears on, or forms part of, Our Site; **Listing** means a requirement for or availability of PPE products posted on Our Site **User** means a user of Our Site; and

## 3. Access to Our Site

3.1 Access to Our Site is free of charge.

4.2 To register for an Account you must hold an NHS email address (nhs.uk or nhs.net) and work for the NHS. This site should not be accessed by anyone outside of the NHS or non-NHS service providers.
4.3 When creating an Account, the information you provide must be accurate and complete. If any of your information changes at a later date, it is your responsibility to ensure that your Account is kept up-to-date.
4.4 We recommend that you choose a strong password for your Account, consisting of a combination of lower and upper case letters, numbers and symbols. It is your responsibility to keep your password safe. If you believe your Account is being used without your permission, please contact Us immediately at support@adviseinc.co.uk. We will not be liable for any unauthorised use of your Account.

4.5 You must not use anyone else's Account or allow anyone to use your Account.

4.6 Any personal information provided in your Account will be collected, used and held in accordance with your rights and our obligations under the law, as set out in Clause 14.

4.7 If you wish to close your Account, you may do so at any time. Closing your Account will result in the removal of your information. Closing your Account will also remove access to any areas of Our Site requiring an Account for access. Data associated with requests which have been uploaded to Our Site will be retained by Us following Account closure.

4.8 We have the right to disable access to your Account, at any time, if in Our reasonable opinion you have failed to comply with any of the provisions of these Terms of Use.

We accept no responsibility for the content of the listings on Our Site. Specifically, you agree, represent and warrant that you have the right to submit the Requests(s), that all information in your Request(s) is accurate and truthful, that all such information will be kept accurate and up-to-date, that no personal data will be included that you do not have the right to include and that all such Listing(s) will comply with Our Acceptable Usage Policy, detailed below in Clause 7.

6.3 You agree that you will be liable to Us and will, to the fullest extent permissible by law, repay us (by indemnifying Us) for any breach of the warranties given by you under subClause 6.2. You will be responsible for any loss or damage suffered by Us as a result of such breach.

# 7. Acceptable Usage Policy

7.1 You may only use Our Site in a manner that is lawful and that complies with the provisions of this Clause 7. Specifically:

7.1.1 you must ensure that you comply fully with any and all applicable local, national, and international laws and/or regulations;

7.2.7 is intended or otherwise likely to infringe (or threaten to infringe) another person's right to privacy or otherwise uses their personal data in a way that you do not have a right to;

7.2.8 misleadingly impersonates any person or business or otherwise misrepresents your identity or affiliation in a way that is calculated to deceive (obvious parodies are not included within this definition provided that they do not fall within any of the other provisions of this sub-Clause 7.2);

7.2.9 implies any form of affiliation with Us where none exists;

7.2.10 infringes, or assists in the infringement of, the intellectual property rights (including, but not limited to, copyright, patents, trademarks and database rights) of any other party; or

7.2.11 is in breach of any legal duty owed to a third party including, but not limited to, contractual duties and duties of confidence.

7.3 We reserve the right to suspend or terminate your Account and/or your access to Our Site if you materially breach the provisions of this Clause 7 or any of the other provisions of these Terms of Use. Specifically, We may take one or more of the following actions:

7.3.1 suspend, whether temporarily or permanently, your Account and/or your right to access Our Site;

7.3.2 remove any Listing posted by you which violates this Acceptable Usage Policy;

7.3.3 issue you with a written warning;

7.3.4 take legal proceedings against you for reimbursement of any and all relevant costs on an indemnity basis resulting from your breach;

7.3.5 take further legal action against you as appropriate;

7.3.6 disclose such information to law enforcement authorities as required or

as We deem reasonably necessary; and/or

7.3.7 any other actions which We deem reasonably appropriate (and lawful).

7.4 We hereby exclude any and all liability arising out of any actions (as set out in clause 7.3 above) that We may lawfully take in response to breaches of these Terms of Use.

8.3.11 infringes, or assists in the infringement of, the intellectual property rights (including, but not limited to, copyright, patents, trademarks and database rights) of any other party; or

8.3.12 is made in breach of any legal duty owed to a third party including, but not limited to, contractual duties and duties of confidence.

8.4 The content restrictions in sub-Clause 8.3 do not apply to content submitted to sites by other Users provided that the primary purpose of the site accords with the provisions of sub-Clause 8.3.
