

NIVS Update 19th Feb 2021.


Dear Colleagues

We are planning a release of some additional data capture items on Sunday 21st ready for Monday 22nd vaccinations. There has been feedback to the program around the need to capture the “Prescribing Method” for the Covid-19 Vaccinations. Following discussions with the Clinical Leads and Prescribing Leads they have asked for the Point of Care Systems such as NIVs to start collecting this item.

On the vaccination record screen there is now a selection of radio buttons call prescribing method

- National Protocol (NP)
- Patient Group Directions (PGD)
- Patient Specific Directions (PSD)

National Protocol is selected by Default, only one option can be selected, the field is Mandatory.
