Following on with program changes, feedback from our user community and service improvements we are implementing the following updates to the NIVS System on Tuesday 25th January at 10pm, ready for vaccinations on the 26th.

5–11-year-old vaccinations

The option to add 5- 11-year-old COVID vaccinations will be available to add into NIVS at point of care. We have attached a user guide to assist with this action.

The process is not changing, you can see in the below screenshot, a pre-screening and a vaccination will still need to be input with all the required information before the vaccination can be saved.



Additional batch

To assist with the above update there is a new vaccine, Comirnaty Children 5-11 years 10 micrograms/0.2 ml dose (Pfizer)

You will still need to add this as a batch before adding it onto vaccinations.



Mandatory Comments Box on Pre-screening

There is now a mandated requirement for justification to be input on the pre-screening when selecting an option that goes outside of JCVI guidance.

This will appear in a mandatory comments box which will have to be completed before proceeding to the vaccination page.



Additional field at the end of the extract

There will now be an additional column in the reporting extracts for “All Events recorded by your organisation – Health & Care Workers and Patients” and “All events recorded for employees of your organisation. The additional column is EventByUser and this is the person who has input the entry onto NIVS
