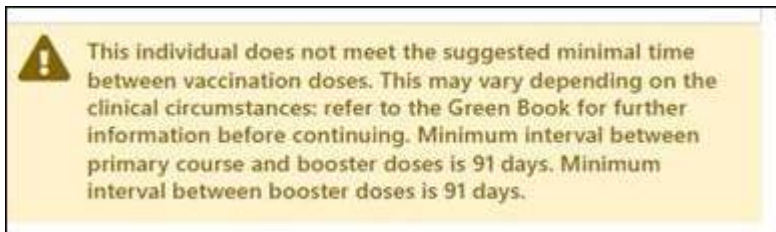
Following National Vaccination Programme requirements, your feedback, and after implementing various Service Improvements we will be introducing several changes in the weeks to come for NIVS.

Warning Changes: 28 March 2022

The advisory message when selecting a Booster dose has been changed to the below for all vaccine recipients aged 12 years old and above. This is to facilitate the entry of subsequent Boosters if required.

Please be aware that this has removed the Immunosuppressed warning but has not affected or changed the vaccination intervals.

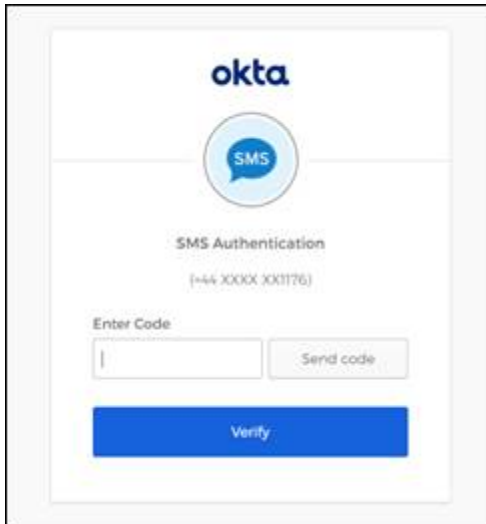

Multi Factor Authentication: Coming Soon

To enhance the security of NIVS, we will be requiring Superusers to identify themselves by more than just a username and password. This will be in form of a PIN that will need to be entered into the logon screen of NIVS.

Please look out for upcoming communications from your SPOC that will contain the process to request MFA and how to use it.
