Dear Colleagues,

Following National Vaccination programme requirements, feedback and after implementing various Service Improvements we will be actioning the below on 28th March.

The advisory message when selecting a Booster dose has been changed to the below for all vaccine recipients aged 12 years old and above. This is to facilitate the entry of subsequent Boosters if required.

Please be aware that this has removed the Immunosuppressed warning, but has not affected or changed the vaccination intervals.

This individual does not meet the suggested minimal time between vaccination doses. This may vary depending on the clinical circumstances: refer to the Green Book for further information before continuing. Minimum interval between primary course and booster doses is 91 days. Minimum interval between booster doses is 91 days.
